

TriHealix, Inc. Completes Acquisition of Assets of RealBenefits

Acquisition extends TriHealix's ability to help providers collect patient out-of-pocket responsibilities.

Norwalk, CT – November 7, 2008 – TriHealix, a developer of innovative technology to streamline the healthcare payments process, recently acquired substantially all of the assets of RealBenefits, Inc. a non-profit technology firm based in Boston.

RealBenefits web-based service allows health care providers and community-based health organizations to accurately screen low income individuals to determine their eligibility and help them enroll in public health and human service programs. This translates into improved access to health care for low-income patients, increased hospital revenues, and reduced administrative and collection costs. RealBenefits, which currently operates in Massachusetts and Illinois, also offers screening for food stamps, energy assistance, and the earned-income tax credit.

The RealBenefits technology will form the foundation of the Patient Assistance product and will expand TriHealix's current provider offerings as both a stand-alone product and as an optional module within the TriHealix Revenue Maximizer, a web-based patient responsibility calculation and payment processing system designed specifically for healthcare providers.

"The Real Benefits acquisition is a tremendous opportunity for TriHealix," said Gregory Morris, co-founder, President and CEO, TriHealix. "When aggregated and integrated into the TriHealix Revenue Maximizer, the combined offering represents a set of unparalleled tools for the provider community to both collect and settle patient out-of-pocket responsibilities."

Healthcare providers using the Revenue Maximizer to determine commercial insurance eligibility and the amount owed by the patient for their care, can benefit both their patients and their practice by adopting the Patient Assistance tool. Patients identified as having no insurance and no means to pay can be systematically screened for eligibility for public medical assistance and hospital charity care programs, thereby minimizing self-pay financial liability for the provider and maximizing coverage for the patient.

"A primary driver behind our decision to join TriHealix is their commitment to continue the original mission of RealBenefits," said Enrique Balaguer, Executive Director of RealBenefits who joins the TriHealix Management Team as Senior Vice President of Public Sector Solutions. "We believe that our combined technologies, resources and knowledge will produce exponentially greater impact on our communities in the months and years ahead while helping providers manage the growing problem of uncompensated care."

TriHealix has already begun integration of the two companies' operations, networks and customer support groups to ensure a smooth transition and immediate value for customers, partners and investors.
